Town of Hume

A regular meeting of the Hume Town Board, Allegany County, Fillmore, New York was held on June 15, 2017. Officials in attendance were: Supervisor Dennis Ricketts, Councilmembers Bruce Hinz, Darlene Mason, and Dan Miller; Deputy Town Clerk Sharon Smith and Town Clerk Susan Bodnar.

Minutes

Councilwoman Mason moved to accept the minutes from the previous meeting of May 2017 as written. Councilman Miller seconded. 4 ayes. 0 noes.

Dog Control Officer

Leslie Clagett shared that the Rabies Clinic that was held in the Town of Hume on June 4th was a success. There were 152 immunizations given. The County was pleased with the outcome.

A reminder letter will be sent to the owners of dogs that were vaccinated in the Township and are not licensed.

Highway

Superintendent Peet shared that Pond Road is paved, the shoulders are done and chip sealed. They will be hot patching in Wiscoy.

Terry Wagoner will be off for 6 weeks. 052They have been crushing gravel behind the highway garage.

Councilman Austin arrived at 7:10PM.

Museum

Dana Arnold came in under the wire with a quote to send to the Department of Education for the grant application that Senator Young's office has had set aside for the museum.

Historian Rondus Miller has been hosting the 4th graders from Fillmore Central School.

Water/Sewer

Suite Kote has been drawing water for its Tankers for the Highway paving project on State Route 19 from the Town well. Dana Potter has been assisting with the process.

Mr. Potter has been assisting with the training of Operator Scott Willgens on the use of the well.

Also, Chris Jones is a Water Operator from Eagle that will be assisting Mr. Willgens with his Class C Water License. Mr. Willgens can obtain his license by a home study course through Rural Water or by taking a 2 day class.

There are still problems with the Sewer Pump and it could be a costly repair. Councilman Austin motioned to bring in MW Controls to repair the problem. Councilman Miller seconded. 5 ayes. 0 noes.

Herb Williams will be having his pool repaired and would like to ask that the Sewer portion of 20,000 Gallons be forgiven because it will not be going through the system but in the pool. Councilman Austin moved to hold the Sewer charge and Councilman Hinz seconded. 5 ayes. 0 noes.

It was also suggested that he contact Brooks Hose to use the hydrant near the house. It would fill the pool faster.

Supervisor

The Town of Hume has previously set their Veteran's exemption for taxes and 15%. The Hume Town Board has decided to stay at that figure. Motion made by Councilman Austin. Seconded by Councilwoman Mason. 5 ayes. 0 noes.

Councilwoman Mason asked Spud Burgess to look at the electric in the old Mobile Station. He said that he would rather not. A recommendation of Lockwood Electric was made to look into the matter.

Teamster Contract

A motion was made by Councilman Austin to accept the Collective Bargaining Agreement and sign the contract. Councilwoman Mason seconded. 5 ayes. 0 noes.

Executive Session

Councilwoman Mason motioned to go into executive session for the purpose to litigate a matter. Councilman Hinz seconded. 5 ayes. 0 noes.

Councilwoman Mason moved to come out of execution session. Councilman Austin seconded the motion. 5 ayes. 0 noes.

Highway

The Board agreed to hire Billy Rose for the Full Time Position, with the stipulation that there will be mandatory overtime and that Mr. Rose is to obtain his Class D Water License. Caleb Potter will be hired as a part time worker with the stipulation that he obtain his CDL. Councilman Austin made the motion. Councilwoman Mason seconded the motion. 5 ayes. 0 noes.

Bills and Reports

Councilwoman Mason motioned to accept the Town Clerk Report and all bills as written. 5 ayes. 0 noes. Supervisor Ricketts seconded the motion. 5 ayes, 0 noes.

Adjournment

Councilwoman Mason moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Miller seconded.
