Authorizes the Town Supervisor to Sign the Part 1 Environmental Assessment Form (EAF).


Directs the Town Clerk to notify interested parties with 30 days notice of Lead Agency.

Thank you for the opportunity to speak on behalf of Cold Creek Cutter.

I am here tonight to propose a potential solution to the voiced frustrations of my customers and towns people who have expressed disappointment regarding the parking lot now owned by DiRienzo's.

Since DiRienzo's are only open 6 months out of the year, and they have barricaded off most of their lot the remaining 6 months they are closed, I am suggesting the Town consider offering to maintain the parking lot in lieu of public use during the months the DiRienzo's are not open for business.

Thereby providing during this time, as was prior to sale of the property to DiRienzo's (formerly municipal parking), overflow parking for the 3 businesses that are open year long while also maintaining a more welcoming esthetic at the main intersection of our town.

A sign could be posted within the lot stating, "Seasonal Public Parking – October, 1 – April 1"
